Electoral Roll Membership

The Parishes Amendment Act 2005 requires your name to be recorded upon our Parish Electoral Roll if you wish to become a voting member of Onslow Anglicans Parish. This is different to the General Parish Roll (pastoral list of members).

You must be on the Parish Roll, to apply to be included on the Electoral Roll. If you are not on our Electoral Roll you will not be able to vote or stand for office.

There are requirements set by the diocese, our governing body, regarding those to be recorded on any parish electoral roll :

- you may be on only one Parish Electoral Roll at a time.
- you must be baptised
- you must have been involved in the full life of the parish for at least four months in the last two (2) years.

Once you have applied for membership to the Electoral Roll, your request will be taken to Vestry at which time you may be added.

We urge you to become a voting member by completing the form over the page and returning it to the **Parish Office**, either by post, dropping in the drop box, or calling into the office personally.
