Rosters—We have been thinking about the way the rosters are structured and how we can lighten the load for those who help out.

We have decided to combine some of the duties at the 10am service so that it is easier to give people a ‘week off’ when they can worship without having to jump up and do something. Further details will come out with the June rosters later this month.

Wellington City Mission Social Supermarket—Wellington City Mission have changed the way they distribute the food donated to them. They have set up a Social Supermarket giving dignity and mana back to those who are experiencing the need to ask for food.

How it works – the food pantry is set up like a normal supermarket with shelves of food and vegetables and all things are given a point value. The guests (Wellington City Mission’s name for those who come to the Mission) are given a set number of points depending on the size of their family. They are met by a volunteer who explains how it works and goes around the supermarket with them. The guest then makes their own choice from the goods available just as we all do at the supermarket. We are sure you will agree this is a much better and much nicer way to give out the food – food choices are different for each of us.

Let’s keep the supermarket shelves full – just bring along your contribution on a Sunday. Remember it’s not only food that is needed but toiletries, soap powder and other personal items as well.
