### Girls

Toy cars and trucks are always a hit with little boys, Lego kits, Beach bag and jandals

For boys aged 10-16, headphones (available from shops like The Warehouse and Kmart)

For boys aged 12-16, toiletry kits (available from department stores like The Warehouse and Kmart)
