A big welcome to Rev. Kay Webster who is here with us today, and welcome back Onslow parishioners. The beginning of a new year and a new decade provides an opportunity for us to reflect on all God's blessings as well as the challenges we will face through 2020.

Use of Drive following new surface—Contour Asphalts have been resurfacing the drive this week and hope to be finished today, Friday.

By Sunday it will be safe to drive through but NOT to park on the “Inward” side, as parking involves hard turning in getting in and out of the park. This leaves only the parks in front of the hall.

After five days, ie. Tuesday or Wednesday, it will be okay to use the drive fully, though we need to be careful for longer. This applies especially to “hard turning”.

Please be watchful, in case the job goes on for longer than expected.

Hall Roof upgrading and repairs—this is still ongoing and will complete once the resurfacing is complete

Following the recent earthquake—25 January—There has been some cracking in one of the uprights between the stained glass windows on the western wall of the church. We have had this inspected by the Diocesan Property Manager and apparently the damages is not structural (i.e. is cosmetic in nature). However, we are also organizing for an expert to examine the damage and advise on how best to remedy it.

Collection of household items for Refugee family— Through the Anglican Movement Refugee Resettlement and the Red Cross Onslow Anglicans have offered to collect household goods for a refugee family of three (a mother and two boys aged 16 and 13). I am the coordinator at our church for this task.

The goods need to be delivered By Me to the Cathedral in Hill Street, Wellington, on Sunday, 23 February between 2-4pm so there’s not much time! This could be the incentive you need to downsize!

We will be collecting General household and Pantry items. It has been stressed that we only collect what is listed because of problems with sorting and storing. I will put up the lists on the board at the back of the church and also arranged for the lists to be sent out by email to parishioners.

If you are happy to contribute items please contact me so I can prevent duplication and see how we are going. Items will need to be delivered here to church on Sundays from 2 February or to our Onslow Anglican Office during office hours, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, 9am -2pm.
