**Get One Give One Campaign** - This campaign is being prepared by Anglican Missions and the Wellington social justice team. Called 'Get One, Give One', the idea is that when every Anglican gets their health-system funded vaccine, they are invited to donate the price of another vaccine for someone in the majority world who otherwise might not get one, or would be delayed in receiving it. Anglican Missions are preparing research from their key sources within government ministries, and at this stage, it is likely the suggested amount will be \$20 per vaccine.

This will be an opportunity to transform lives and make a difference for the vulnerable in the name of Jesus. As soon as we have more details, we will let you know.

**Ngaio**—We thought you may be interested in the latest news of the development of the All Saints site in Ngaio.

A resource consent is being applied for by Prime Property for 18 dwellings. It keeps the existing house down the back, has six three storey units to the north of the church (slightly over the 8m height limit for the site), two on the land to the south i.e. above Crofton Road, and 9 apartments in the church building between 28m<sup>2</sup> and 53 m<sup>2</sup>. Only 17 car parks being provided, which includes two for the existing dwelling.
