Outreach – an update on what is happening

Family History group. Eileen says “the group managed to have its second meeting on 7 October and had 12 people turn up, including a couple of new people (one of those being a young school student, which was lovely). Allowing for those who couldn't come this time, it means there are now 16 on the (informal) membership list, so I'm quite encouraged! Our next meeting will be on Thursday next week, 4 November, 2pm - 4pm, and I'm hopeful we'll be able to be back in the upstairs room. The cost is \$3.00, which includes a cup of tea and a biscuit. The focus this time is for people to bring an item of family memorabilia and talk about its significance to them.

Community Garden This will be in the former BHK outdoor area. Once again this is a project being lead by Eileen who has been in touch with a group called "Seeds to Feeds" who are trying to get something up and running in the Khandallah area. Eileen says “A lady named Lauren, who used to be involved in the Hataitai Seeds to Feeds project, has recently moved to Khandallah and is keen to be involved, and there are one or two others as well, including some from the little community garden on the corner of Mandalay Terrace. Gendy Thomson, Archdeacon for Mission and Ministry in the diocese, has put me in touch with Lauren and I am due to meet with her on Saturday. There is then to be a meeting of the wider group on Sunday afternoon, at the Khandallah community centre.”

There are some other ideas in the pipeline including a craft group and branded merchandise with the Onslow Church Logo on them. As always, all these things needed people power – please let us know if you are able to help – together we can do so much.
