Diocesan news—On Tuesday the wardens attended a Zoom meeting to update parish leaders on things happening around the Diocese. Here are some of the things we were told about:

There will be a Training Day on 31 July at Samuel Marsden Collegiate School from 9.30am – 4pm. All are welcome. As further details come out, we will pass these on to you.

‘Season of Creation’ – 1 September – 4 October. A special time to celebrate creation. Again, as more information is available, we will share it with you.

‘Lessen Our Carbon Footprint’ – another initiative by the Diocese. There will be the chance to sign up as a parish to look at our carbon footprint and make the effort to reduce it.

We were encouraged to return to/continue our rhythms of prayer. This could be by meeting up with others face to face and praying together, meeting using Zoom to pray together or simply setting aside a time each day to pray.

Jammies in June and July—To help keep kids warm and well this winter, Wellington Hospitals Foundation has launched its annual Jammies in June Appeal. Respiratory conditions are a leading cause of acute admissions to hospital for children and Wellington Regional Children’s Hospital sees a significant increase in the number of children who are admitted over the winter months - many of them arriving without a pair of pyjamas.

In previous years you have been very generous with your donations – can we top last year’s 24 pairs this year? They need flannelette pyjamas in sizes 1-16 or if you prefer thermals in same size range.

The last Sunday for donations is 18 July – there is a box in church near the pulpit for you to drop off your donation. We will then deliver them to the hospital. If you are not able to get to the shops but would like to donate just pop some money in an envelope clearly marked Jammies in June and Lee will go shopping for you.

Rosters—The rosters for July and August will be out next week. We have a real problem with a lack of people to fill roles so have decided that, to ease the strain, there will be only one sides person. They will ask for help on the day should they need it. We are also short of people to do morning tea at 10am. This does not have to involve home baking – a biscuit is fine – it’s a time of fellowship.

Please consider if you are able to help with either of these roles or indeed any of the others. Just let Lee know.

Get One Give One Campaign - Our Bishops - +Justin and +Ellie, are encouraging parishes to get behind this campaign. As you know from last week’s Warden’s Words this is a very worthy cause which will give the opportunity for those in countries that cannot afford the vaccine the chance to be immunised.

All you need to do is when you get your Covid-19 vaccine, give \$10 so that one of the world’s most vulnerable can get theirs. \$50 covers a family of five and \$100 will cover two families.
