Get One Give One Campaign

This campaign is being prepared by Anglican Missions and the Wellington social justice team. Called 'Get One, Give One', the idea is that when every Anglican gets their health-system funded vaccine, they are invited to donate the price of another vaccine for someone in the majority world who otherwise might not get one, or would be delayed in receiving it. Anglican Missions are preparing research from their key sources within government ministries, and, at this stage, it is likely the suggested amount will be \$20 per vaccine.

This will be an opportunity to transform lives and make a difference for the vulnerable in the name of Jesus. As soon as we have more details, we will let you know.
